The FQHC's seventh medical office, at 1199 Main Street in Fairfax, will be known as Fairfax Health Center after the merger. NOTCH will continue to deliver medical and behavioral health services at Fairfax Health Center employing the practice's current staff. In the coming year, Audrey von Lepel, M.D. will teach healthful cooking classes along with talks on food as medicine for osteoporosis, diabetes, cholesterol management as well as other topics. These classes will be announced.

Dr. von Lepel has practiced medicine in Fairfax since 1990. Beginning October 1st, Fairfax Health Center patients will have access to NOTCH sliding fee scales for medical, dental, and pharmacy services. They will also have access to prescription bubble packaging at NOTCH Pharmacy. In a letter to her patients, Dr. von Lepel wrote, "Fairfax Associates in Medicine is merging with NOTCH to guarantee that we can continue to offer the care you have all come to expect.
