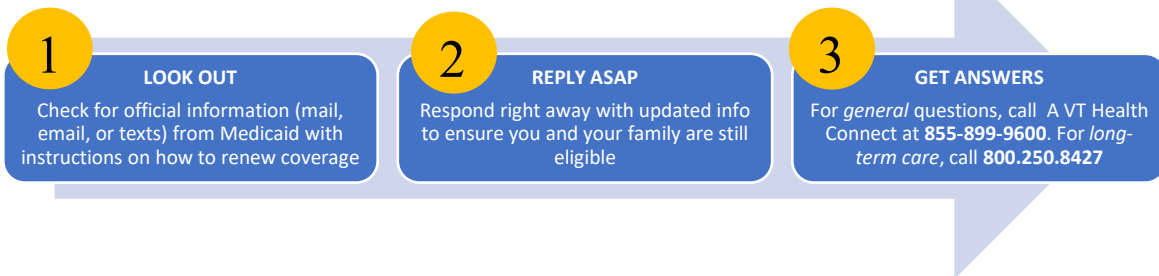

Medicaid Renewals to Restart in 2023



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: *What is happening?*

Starting in April 2023, Medicaid will be issuing renewal notices to patients. It is expected to take up to 12 months for all notices of renewal to be sent. Patients are required to renew their Medicaid insurance.

Q: *Do all individuals with Medicaid need to renew their insurance?*

A: Medicaid will be able to process many renewals automatically based on information available. In some situations, Medicaid will need to ask you for information about yourself and your family, like address, employment and income, age, and the number of people in your household.

MEDICAID INCOME ELIGIBILITY

- Individuals earning up to **\$18,764/year**
- Parents in a family of 4 earning up to **\$38,300/year**
- Children in a family of 4 earning up to **\$87,968/year**.

Q: *What do I need to do before getting the renewal notice?*

A: Medicaid encourages individuals to make sure their mailing address, phone number, and email address are up-to-date so that their renewal reaches them. Log in to your account at www.VermontHealthConnect.gov or call 1-855-899-9600. This is very important as it allows Medicaid to make sure you receive your renewal notice.

Q: *How will I receive my renewal notice?*

A: When it is your turn to renew, Medicaid will mail you more information. Look out for the envelope with the red stripe. Vermonters will receive their renewal notices at different times over the unwind period. Most households will receive a text message or postcard in advance of this mailing.
